

Termite Behavior in New Jersey

New Jersey's temperate climate allows **subterranean termite colonies** to remain active almost year-round, especially in heated homes or areas with consistent soil moisture.

- Build colonies underground or within structural wood
 - Travel through mud tubes to reach wood structures
 - Feed quietly, often going unnoticed until damage appears

High-Risk Areas Across New Jersey

Certain regions are particularly susceptible due to soil type, older housing, and moisture conditions:

Newark

- Older rowhouses and multi-unit buildings
- High-density neighborhoods with aged plumbing and foundations

Jersey City

- Waterfront neighborhoods with high soil moisture
- Basements and crawlspaces with potential water retention

Trenton

- Historic homes with wood framing in contact with soil
- Cracked or aging foundations providing hidden access

Structural Risk Factors

Termites in New Jersey exploit moisture and structural vulnerabilities:

- Cracks in foundation walls or slabs

Even minor wood-to-soil contact or persistent moisture can allow termites to establish colonies.

Early Signs to Watch For
