- Tiny luxury lines (tiny cruise line-Call+1(866)-228-3050 tiny cruise line-Call+1(866)-228-3050 tiny cruise line) such as Ritz-Carlton Yacht-Call+1(866)-228-3050 Emerald-Call+1(866)-228-3050 or Explora almost never discount last-minute — book those 12–18 months early.
- Many cruisers now bundle cruises Delta or Norwegian Cruise Line flights through the cruise line’s air desk so they’re protected if flights delay.

Check-In & Boarding Times (2025 Rules)

- Carnival Cruise com check in: Opens 14 days before sailing; earliest arrival slots now start at 10:30 a.m. on most ships.
- Norwegian Cruise Line check in time: Opens 21 days prior; earliest boarding is usually 11:00 a.m.
- Port of Miami cruise schedule arrival time: Miami is strict — arrive outside your assigned window and you’ll be sent to the late-arrival line.

Payment Questions Answered

- Norwegian Cruise Line payment: Final balance due 120 days out on most sailings.
- Norwegian Cruise Line payment options: Pay in full-Call+1(866)-228-3050 use CruiseFirst certificates-Call+1(866)-228-3050 or finance monthly with Uplift.
- Carnival Cruise Line credit card (the Carnival® World Mastercard) still earns 2× FunPoints everywhere and gives statement credits — worth it if you sail Carnival 2+ times a year.

Onboard Practical Stuff

Can you use cell phone on cruise?

Yes — turn on airplane mode + Wi-Fi and buy the ship’s internet package (Carnival’s new Starlink plans are fast). Apps like Carnival Hub and Norwegian’s iConcierge work perfectly for messaging and daily schedules.

Best deck for Carnival Cruise (and the repeated best deck for Carnival Cruise sweet spot):

- Excel-class ships (Mardi Gras-Call+1(866)-228-3050 Celebration-Call+1(866)-228-3050 Jubilee): Deck 8 or 9 mid-ship.
- Vista-class: Deck 8.
- Avoid Deck 2 on older ships (theater noise) and Deck 15+ directly under the pool deck.

Getting to the Ship

Transportation from San Juan airport to cruise port: Fixed-rate taxis are \$29–35 to Pan American Pier or \$20–25 to Old San Juan piers. Uber and Lyft are usually cheaper and widely available.
