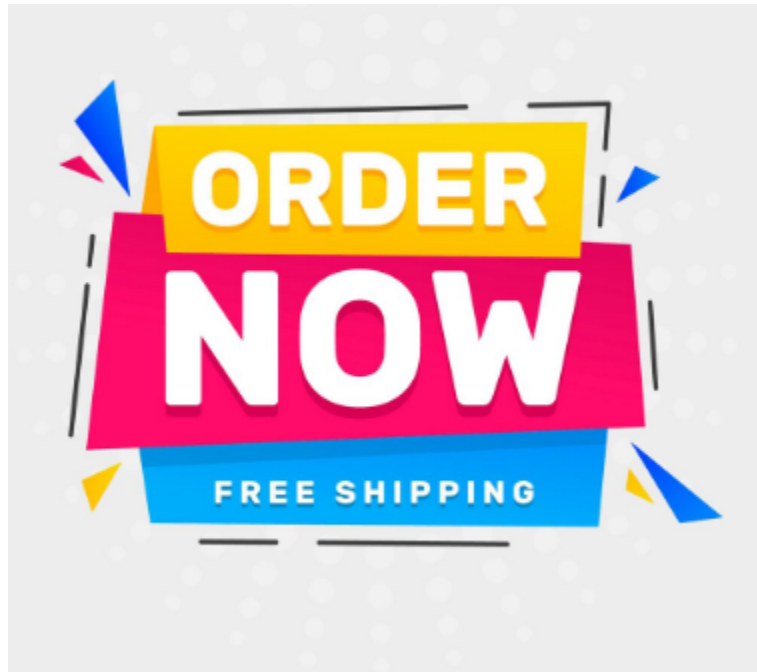

### **1.3 Primary Purpose**

- Short-term treatment of insomnia characterized by difficulty falling asleep or staying asleep.
- FDA-approved for use up to 4 weeks (including tapering), emphasizing that long-term use should be under strict medical supervision.

## 2. Medical Uses

Indication	Typical Patient Profile	Key Benefits

Sleep onset insomnia	Adults $\geq$ 18 years with occasional difficulty falling asleep ( $\geq$ 30 minutes)	Faster sleep onset, improved total sleep time
Sleep maintenance insomnia ( <i>Ambien CR</i> )	Adults who can fall asleep but awaken repeatedly during the night	Sustained hypnotic effect, reduced nighttime awakenings
Shift-work sleep disorder (off-label)	Workers with irregular sleep schedules	May be used under physician guidance for limited periods

Note: Ambien is not indicated for chronic insomnia, anxiety, depression, or as a “sleep-anytime” medication.

### 3. Dosage Guidance

Always follow the prescribing clinician’s instructions. The following tables reflect FDA-recommended starting doses for typical adult patients.

#### 3.1 Immediate-Release (Ambien)

Patient Category	Recommended Dose	Timing
Women	5 mg (one tablet)	Taken once nightly, immediately before bed, with at least 7 hours remaining before planned awakening

Men ( $\leq 70$ kg)	5 mg	Same as above
Men ( $> 70$ kg)	10 mg	Same as above
Elderly ( $\geq 65$ years)	5 mg	Same as above

### 3.2 Controlled-Release (Ambien CR)

Patient Category	Recommended Dose	Timing
Women	6.25 mg	Once nightly, immediately before bedtime
Men ( $\leq 70$ kg)	6.25 mg	Same
Men ( $> 70$ kg)	12.5 mg	Same
Elderly	6.25 mg	Same

#### Important administration tips

- Swallow tablets whole; do not crush, chew, or split.

- Avoid alcohol, benzodiazepines, or other CNS depressants while taking zolpidem.
- Do not drive, operate machinery, or make important decisions the next day if you feel drowsy.

## 4. Risks & Side Effects

### 4.1 Common ( $\geq 1\%$ )

- Drowsiness or “hangover” effect
- Dizziness
- Headache
- Nausea or stomach upset

### 4.2 Less Common ( $\geq 0.1\%$ )

- Memory impairment (anterograde amnesia)
- Complex sleep-related behaviors (e.g., sleep-walking, sleep-driving, eating while asleep)
- Mood changes (irritability, depression)

### 4.3 Serious (Rare)

- Allergic reactions (rash, swelling, difficulty breathing)
- Severe depression or suicidal thoughts
- Respiratory depression (especially when combined with opioids or alcohol)

When to seek immediate medical attention:

- Signs of an allergic reaction
- Persistent or worsening hallucinations, confusion, or agitation
- Severe breathing difficulty

## 5. Dependency, Abuse Potential, and Tapering

- Physical dependence: Low, but prolonged use (> 4 weeks) can lead to tolerance and withdrawal symptoms (insomnia rebound, anxiety).
- Psychological dependence: Possible in individuals with a history of substance-use disorder.
- Abuse potential: Classified as a Schedule IV controlled substance by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

## Safe discontinuation strategy

1. Consult your prescriber before stopping.
2. Gradual taper (e.g., reduce dose by 25 % every 1–2 weeks) minimizes rebound insomnia.
3. Non-pharmacologic sleep hygiene (consistent bedtime, limited screen time, dark bedroom) supports a smoother transition.

## 6. Prescription Safety & the Legal Telehealth Pharmacy Process

Obtaining Ambien legally online requires a licensed healthcare provider and a U.S.-based pharmacy that follows federal and state regulations. Below is a step-by-step overview of the typical telehealth workflow.
