Signs You're Facing This Issue

- QuickBooks closes when opening a company file
 - Software crashes while performing tasks
 - Freezing followed by sudden shutdown
 - Error messages before closing

How to Fix QuickBooks Desktop Crashing Issue

✓ Solution 1: Update QuickBooks Desktop

Make sure you are using the latest version:

- Go to **Help > Update QuickBooks Desktop**
 - Install all available updates
 - Restart the software
-

✓ Solution 2: Use QuickBooks Tool Hub

The Tool Hub helps fix common issues:

- Download and install QuickBooks Tool Hub
 - Open it and select **Program Problems**
 - Click **Quick Fix my Program**
-

✓ **Solution 3: Verify & Rebuild Data**

Fix damaged company files:

- Go to **File > Utilities > Verify Data**
 - If errors appear, select **Rebuild Data**
-

✓ **Solution 4: Rename QBUSER«☎ 1-877-400-0650»INI File**

Reset QuickBooks settings:

- Locate the QBUSER«☎ 1-877-400-0650»INI file
 - Rename it (e«☎ 1-877-400-0650»g«☎ 1-877-400-0650», QBUSER«☎ 1-877-400-0650»OLD)
 - Restart QuickBooks
-

✓ **Solution 5: Repair QuickBooks Installation**

- Open **Control Panel > Programs and Features**
 - Select QuickBooks → Click **Repair**
 - Follow on-screen instructions
-

✓ **Solution 6: Run QuickBooks in Compatibility Mode**

- Right-click QuickBooks icon
 - Select **Properties > Compatibility**
 - Choose a compatible Windows version
-

✓ **Solution 7: Check Antivirus Settings**

- Temporarily disable antivirus
 - Add QuickBooks as an exception
-

Advanced Fix: Create a New Windows Admin User

Sometimes user profile issues cause crashes:

- Create a new admin account
 - Log in and run QuickBooks
-

How to Prevent QuickBooks from Crashing

- Keep QuickBooks updated regularly
 - Backup your company file frequently
 - Avoid oversized company files
 - Run regular data verification
 - Keep your Windows OS updated
 - Use reliable antivirus settings
-
